How To Use Your Warrior

Thank you for using a BikeAway Warrior – the simplest, most secure way to store your bike. Instructions on how to use your locker are inside of the door, but you may find the following information helpful.

<u>CARE:</u> Always pull the locker door before walking away to ensure it is secured. A locker not locked correctly is the most common reason for bikes being stolen.

Storing Your Bike

Most people can store a bike in a Warrior in less than 10 seconds by following our simple steps:

Step 1 – To operate the lock, use your knee to push on the door as indicated. Remove the padlock and push the latch inwards, allowing it to rotate through 90 degrees. The door will now open.

Step 2 – Grab the Securing Loop (bright red) and push it up the track toward the roof.

Step 3 – Stand your bike on its back wheel outside of the locker. To do this, we suggest you stand behind your bike, hold the handlebars with one hand and the saddle with the other. Engage the back brake and step backwards, allowing the front wheel of the bike to rise up. Only let the rear brake off when the bike is fully vertical and you are ready to move it forwards.

Step 4 – Wheel your bike towards the Warrior and guide the front wheel gently into the small track below the red loop you raised previously. Large bikes may need the handle bars angled to fit through the door. At the same time, guide the rear wheel onto the base of the Warrior and up onto the red ramp. Take care - if you accidentally bang the back of the BikeAway with the front wheel, the red loop may slither down, in which case you will need to take the bike out and start again.

Step 5 – When your bike is in position, grab the front edge of the red Securing Loop again, lift it slightly, then lower it over your bike tyre - your bike is then secured.

Step 6 – To lock the Warrior, use your knee to press the door closed where indicated. Push and rotate the latch 90 degrees clockwise then pull out, enabling you to refit and lock the padlock.

For maximum security use your own padlock - a Sold Secure Bicycle Gold compliant Sterling SPL 100 can be purchased from us. Please retain the original padlock which will need to be refitted when you finish your rental period. If you wish to secure your bike within the locker, this can be done by using your own chain through the red hoop.

Removing Your Bike

Simply grab your bike by the saddle and pull it towards you. The front wheel of your bike will fall away from the red Securing Loop. Should the front wheel jam, simply rotate it clockwise to free it.

Finally

If you do find Warrior a little tricky to use the first time, don't worry, all you need to do is take your time. As with most things, practice makes perfect.
