

# **COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

## **1. The promoter**

The promoter is: University of London of Senate House, Malet Street, London, WC1E 7HU.

## **2. The competition**

The title of the competition is the 'UoL Halls Recycling Rockstar Quiz'

## **3. How to enter**

**3.1** The competition will run from 8:00am on Tuesday 01 September 2026 (the "Opening Date") to 17:00pm on Friday 16th October 2026 (the "Closing Date") inclusive.

**3.2** Participants will be entered into a "Prize Draw" if they answer all questions in the 'Recycling Rockstar' quiz and then provide the following contact details to be eligible for the prize draw:

i. First name

ii. Email address

iii. Hall of Residence

**3.3** All competition entries must be received by the Promoter by no later than 17:00 on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after the Closing Date will not be eligible for entry into the prize draw.

**3.4.** By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

**3.5.** The competition entries from each University of London Hall will be pooled and entries will be drawn at random from each pool. The number of entries to be drawn from each Hall's pool will be in proportion to the ratio of entrants from that Hall relative to the total number of entrants.

## **4. Eligibility**

**4.1.** The competition is only open to all students residing in University of London halls.

**4.2** Entrants are only eligible for one prize irrespective of the number of entries made.

## **5. The prize/s**

5.1. There are forty (40) prizes of **£10 Waterstones gift cards**

5.2. Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for prizes. The Promoter reserves the right to substitute a prize with a prize of equal value.

5.3. The Promoter reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal value if circumstances beyond the Promoter's control makes it necessary to do so.

5.4. The prizes are not negotiable or transferable.

## **6. Winners**

6.1. The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

6.2. The Promoter will contact the winner(s) after the Prize Draw Announcement Date, using the email address provided with the prize draw entry.

6.3 The prize will be delivered to the Reception of the relevant Hall of Residence for winners to collect. Winners have 30 days to collect their prize from Reception.

## **7. Claiming the prize**

If winners cannot be contacted on the email details provided or do not respond to the Promoter to claim their prize within thirty 30 days of being notified of their win, the winner's prize will be forfeited and the Promoter will be entitled to offer the prize to the next selected eligible entrant from entries received before the Closing Date.

## **8. Limitation of liability**

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner(s) or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

## **9. Data protection and publicity**

The Promoter will only process your personal information as set out the Privacy Notice (Annex 1).

## **10. General**

10.1.If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.

10.2.The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.

10.3. These terms and conditions are governed by English law. If any entrants to this promotion wish to take court proceedings, then they must in the English courts.
